Since retirement, he has focussed on writing shorter pieces concerned with boundaries/margins/mobility and on empire and its aftereffects. He is also preparing a memoir currently entitled 'Living with British Post-Imperialism: a Memoir' From 2003 to 2016, Associate Professor in Political Theory and the History of Ideas at the University of Copenhagen.
