Portfolio exam

The portfolio exam is passed by submitting two compulsory assignments in Absalon during the course.

If an assignment is not approved on the first attempt, it may be re-submitted once in revised form on the re-submission. The assessments should be registered by no later than 25th January 2021 at 12:00 noon Danish time for the autumn semester.

The make-up and resit exam is passed through a free assignment. The free assignment must be submitted in the Digital Exam System.

Each assignment must not exceed:
