INFORMATION CONCERNING EXAMS DURING WINTER 2020/21

Deadline for applications for exemption

If you wish to apply for an exemption concerning special exam conditions for your Winter 2020/21 exams, you must apply for an exemption **by no later than 12:00 noon 2 October 2020**. Timetables

The final timetables for oral exams will be announced via the course room in Absalon on the date announced in the exam schedule below.

If you will be taking exams at other departments in January 2020, you must notify this to the study administration as soon as possible, to avoid exam conflicts with your oral exams at Department of Political Science. Remember to include documentation. The deadline for enquiries of this nature concerning the Winter exams is 12:00 noon 16 November 2020.

Announcement of grades

The grades for written exams will be published via Student Self Service on KUnet on the date stated in the exam plan via Student Self Service on KUnet.dk

If, contrary to expectations, the grades are not available by the date published in the overall exam plan, you can contact the member of administrative staff responsible for the exam in question, for an explanation (Find information for the specific exam in the Digital Exam System).

NB! For the Master Thesis, the deadline for the announcement of the grade is one month after the deadline for submission.

Deregistration for exam

You are automatically signed up for your first exam attempt. If you wish to change your exam registration for the ordinary winter exam 2020/21, this can only be done in the exam registration period, September 9-16, 2020.

Registration for re-examination

If you fail an exam or have to take a re-exam for other reasons, you must actively register for the reexam. No students are automatically registered for the re-exam. You can register for the re-exam winter 2020/21 in the exam registration period January 27-February 3, 2021.
