Deadline for applications for exemption

If you wish to apply for exemption concerning special exam conditions for your Winter 2018/19 exams, you must submit an application to the Board of Studies **by no later than 12:00 noon 1 October 2018**. Timetables

The final timetables for oral exams will be announced via the course room in Absalon on the date renounced in the exam schedule below.

If you will be taking exams at other departments in January 2019, you must notify this to the study administration as soon as possible, to avoid exam conflict with your oral exams under Political Science. Remember to include documentation. The deadline for enquiries of this nature concerning the Winter exams is 12:00 noon 15 November 2018.
